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Size Selection

There are three sizes of anti-slip floor decals. Each is made to suit a different environment.

Sizes:

7-1/2" diameter	Ideal for slip-protection on narrow paths or steps.		
17" diameter	Perfect for creating a pathway that directs traffic while decreasing slips.		
24" diameter	Well-suited to curb accidents on slippery floors and message forklift drivers and staff.		

Installation

Anti-slip floor decals are easy to install. A plastic backing is removed to expose a tacky adhesive. (See the guide above to know what decal is for your floor.)

- 1. Clean surface that decal will be applied to.
- 2. Make sure the surface is dried after cleaning. (No liquid should be present when applying adhesive.)
- 3. Peel layer off the back of your decal (the non-textured side).
- 4. Press tacky-side of decal to floor.
