## ■ SDS (Safety Data Sheet) Requirements

### ■ Problem:

Andrew, a Safety Manager, purchases 15 different chemicals for use in his manufacturing operation. When he performs an audit of his facility's SDS library, **he notices that many documents are**

**four years old and he isn't sure if they follow the new format outlined in the new GHS standard.** What should he do to comply?

### ■ Solution:

To comply with GHS, Andrew must get these older safety data sheets (SDSs) updated to the standardized 16-section format outlined in the Hazcom standard. To do so, he can call the

manufacturer or visit their website to download the newly formatted documents. He should then add them to his facility's SDS library for his employees to access and reference.
