

Pictogram Reference Sheet

GHS-compliant labels feature one or more universally recognized pictograms which convey important information about chemical hazards in your workplace.

Post this free sheet around your facility to educate employees about the nine GHS pictograms and their meanings.

EXPLODING BOMB

Explosives, self-reactives, organic peroxides



GAS CYLINDER

Compressed gases; liquefied gases; dissolved gases



HEALTH HAZARD

Carcinogens, respiratory sensitizers, reproductive toxicity, target organ toxicity, germ cell mutagens



FLAME

Flammable gases, liquids, & solids; self-reactives; pyrophorics; self-heating



CORROSIVE

Skin corrosion; eye damage



SKULL AND CROSSBONES

Acute toxicity (severe, fatal)



FLAME OVER CIRCLE

Oxidizing gases, liquids and solids



EXCLAMATION MARK

Irritant, dermal sensitizer, acute toxicity (harmful)



ENVIRONMENT

Aquatic toxicity
(Not regulated by OSHA)
